S/Sgt Edward W. Masterman graduated from Selah High School in 1940 and attended college. He was employed at the Boeing Aircraft Company.

The ship was so badly damaged by flak that Lt Kaufman ordered the crew to bail out. This was on the Dutch coast, and six of the crew were blown out to sea and lost. Two delayed their drop and landed safely.

B-17G 42-31098 (IW-B - Penny's Thunderhead) landed at Lindholme RAF base, Yorkshire, after sustaining heavy battle damage (eight crew members having bailed out).
