He joined the National Guard in Genesco, New York on 27 January 1941 and later was transferred to the Air Corps. He was graduated as a bombardier in February 1943.

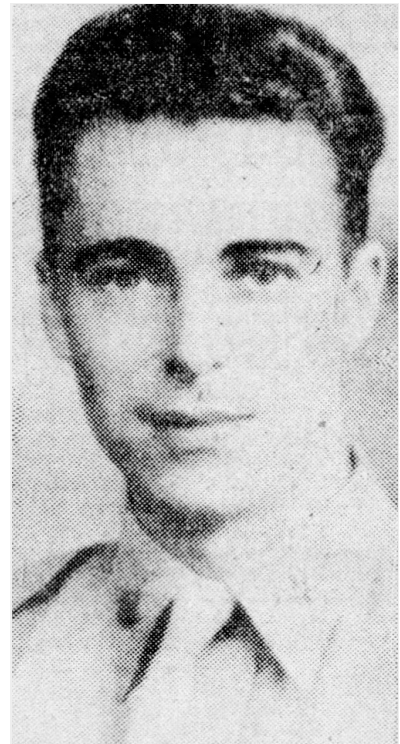
His son, Richard Stanley, was born 10 days after his father was shot down.
