Pfc Harvey M. Whiteside Jr. graduated from East Lampeter High School in 1940 and was employed at the Armstrong Cork Company.

 $He\ enlisted\ in\ Harrisburg,\ Pennsylvania\ on\ 17\ November\ 1942\ and\ sent\ overseas\ in\ April\ 1943.$

He was wounded during the invasion of Sicily and spent six months in a hospital in North Africa. He rejoined his company in England and took part in the D-Day invasion of France.

Pfc Whiteside was first buried at the Temporary American Military Cemetery in Solers, France.
