

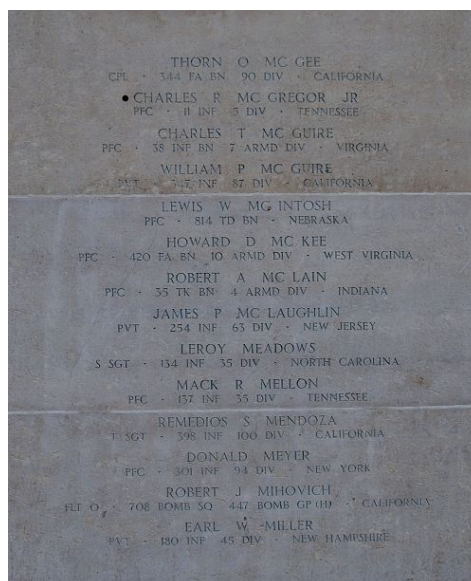

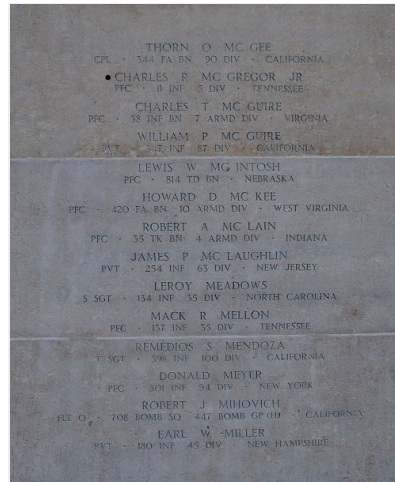

Pfc Donald Meyer joined the Air Corps of the U.S. Army Reserve in Rutland, Vermont on 23 July 1943.
