Pvt Macy L. Krawiec graduated from Lodi High School and had a post graduate degree and worked in a petroleum company.

He joined the Regular Army on 23 May 1939. After serving abroad for some time, he returned to the United States and volunteered for the paratroopers, for which he trained at Fort Benning, Georgia. The facts about him being transferred to the infantry are not known at this moment.

At the time of his death, the 2nd Infantry Regiment was in a holding position along the Kyll River.

His brother Edward served in the Pacific.
