The family moved to Ramona, South Dakota around 1920, where Edmund Timmons attended Ramona High School for three years. He went to work for the Milwaukee Railroad, where his father was the Section Foreman. He married Dorothy Schwartz in Sioux Falls on September 21, 1937.
